DATA PROTECTION POLICY

Dear Academician,

You may be aware that the European Union has adopted a new General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) which entered into force on May 25, 2018. Pursuant to the GDPR, the International Academy of Aviation and Space Medicine (IAASM) is requesting that you give your consent to collect, store, process and use personal information and data previously submitted or to be submitted in the future, for the one or more of the following purposes:

1. your nomination for membership;
2. admission to membership;
3. nomination for service as an officer of the IAASM;
4. service on any IAASM committee, subcommittee, panel, or other *ad hoc* or standing body, including those which are intended to or may produce a report or other document for publication or other distribution, including by electronic means, by the IAASM;
5. participation in any activities or events sponsored or co-sponsored or organized or co-organized by the IAASM, including conferences, symposia, workshops, colloquia and other meetings;
6. share your contact information for IAASM related purposes with meeting organizers and co-sponsors, and scientific entities collaborating with the IAASM on specifically defined projects;
7. invoicing and payment of your membership dues, or invoicing and payment for any functions, services, goods or donations;
8. sending you digital or postal communication and keeping you informed of or involved in IAASM related activities.

Such personal information and data may include the following:

1. first name;
2. middle name(s) or middle initial(s);
3. last name;
4. title;
5. date of birth;
6. nationality;
7. mailing address;
8. e-mail address(es);
9. phone number(s);
10. affiliation;
11. position;
12. previous affiliations;
13. academic background and degrees;

14. scientific research; publications; contributions to IAASM activities;
15. participation in IAASM events or events of IAASM partner organizations;
16. Curriculum Vitae.

In addition, the IAASM may collect, store and process other personal information and data including social media addresses, still photographs, and video and audio recordings and images.

The IAASM may obtain banking and/or credit card account numbers and information for purposes of processing payments for dues, functions, services, goods or donations. Such information will be destroyed/deleted from Academy records once any relevant financial transaction has been successfully completed.

It is acknowledged that the IAASM maintains or may maintain in the future, an internet and social media presence through its website at <https://www.iaasm.org> with certain personal information available to the public, which may include your name, affiliation, membership category, nationality and your attendance and/or participation in IAASM events, including individual and group photographs, and live or pre-recorded audio and video of your voice and likeness by streaming or otherwise. It is further acknowledged that the IAASM website contains a database with your email address that if you so choose will be made available to other IAASM members in a user name and password restricted area.

It is acknowledged that the IAASM is incorporated in New Zealand, and your personal information may be collected, processed and stored outside of New Zealand or the European Union by the IAASM and/or partner organizations or event co-organizers or co-sponsors, and that the laws of such locations may not protect your personal information or may not provide the same level of legal protection as is provided by the laws and regulations of New Zealand or the European Union and its member states. However, nothing contained herein is intended to nor shall it operate to abrogate any right of access, rectification and suppression of data under the law of the jurisdiction of your residence or domicile.

I hereby give my consent to the IAASM to collect, process and store my personal information as set forth above. I acknowledge that I may revoke all or part of this consent at any time by providing written notice to the IAASM.
